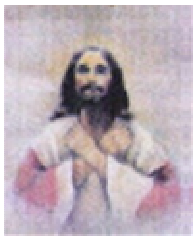

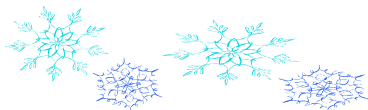

DO YOU OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW WEAR HEARING AIDS?

Hearing Loop informational meeting

Hearing Loops allow people who wear hearing aids to hear the sound from a microphone directly in hearing aids just by activating the T-coil. If you or someone you know where hearing aids you will need to find out if you have this wireless receiver called a t-coil built in your hearing aids (most do, although that feature is not always activated by your audiologist when you purchased your hearing aids).
